




MARIALUISA: I FEEL BLESSED TO HAVE HILDE AS MY SPONSOR (Unedited)



ZOOMcatalog also matched the employees' donations on behalf of the whole team. Your caring donations are very much appreciated by the Delgado's and BSF!!!!!





What a fun experience to fine-tune the food with the wines! A great food and wine pairing create a balance between the components of

a dish and the characteristics of a wine and heightens the overall experience. Susanne is a master in looking at what wines pair well with what foods. The real





excitement was in the experimentation - deciding on the three courses and then embellishing on them by adding a little bit of bleu cheese, a little bit of bacon, a little bit of jalapeño, a little bit of basil, a little bit of this and a little bit of that! All these heightened the flavors of the three courses to be served. And those flavors brought out the full body of the three wines chosen from the Black Cross Winery. After many sips of wine and many sample tastings, the menu and wine pairing were complete.
