After finishing high school, I was ready for the following step and I was able to enter the university to study a Nursing Degree in Tijuana. Enrolling was easy, but it was difficult to arrive on time for classes since I stared classes at 7:00 am and finished at 4:00 pm for 4 years. There were days when I only slept 3 hours. I chose my social service at the Rosarito General Hospital. I spent a year there, year learning from magnificent nurses and great human beings.

opted to apply for employment in the afternoons at a clinic in Rosarito. (Which they accepted me). In the mornings I did my social service where I had to wake up at 5:00 am to be able to take my taxi at 6 am and get there on time. In the afternoons, after leaving my service, I transported to my work from 1:00 pm to 10:00 pm. I sometimes arrived home at 11:00 pm, tired but happy that they gave me the opportunity to work and carry out my social service. After finishing my social service I took the EGEL exam.
